<p>Invade (verb)</p>		<p>To invade a country means to enter it by force with an army.</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> To know that the Vikings conflicted with the Anglo-Saxons between 793AD to 1066AD for control over Britain. They travelled from Scandinavia and landed in Lindisfarne. To know that the Anglo-Saxons came looking for farm land and the Vikings were also searching for farm land and treasures to make them rich. They stole treasures from Monasteries To know the Vikings came from Scandinavia (Norway, Sweden and Denmark) on longships and stole gold and jewels from monks in monasteries To know many British places were named by the Vikings (the suffix -by coming from the Scandinavian word for 'homestead' or 'village'. To know that the Vikings captured 'Jorvik' (York) and was the Viking capital in England Exciting books I can read:
