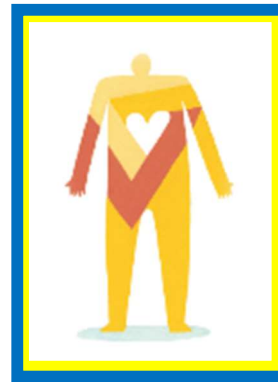
Jesus
(noun)

Jesus is the name of God's son.
He is very special.



nativity
(noun)

A story told about somebodies' birth. Christians have nativity plays to tell the story of Jesus' birth.



Incarnation means that Jesus is God in the flesh, and that, in Jesus, God came to live among humans.



Christmas
(noun)

A Christian celebration held every year to celebrate the birth of Jesus.



Christians go to church at Christmas time.
